Mathematics

Before half term, we will continue to lean about shape, geometry and statistics. Once we have covered the Year 6 curriculum, in addition to revision of key facts, we also delve deeper into mathematical concepts and investigations, including: binary numbers, the Fibonacci sequence and the work of famous mathematicians,

English

In our Master Reader lessons, we will be reading Eren and Street Child.

Our writing lessons will cover a wide range of genres including: non-chronological reports, writing from different perspectives, conveying differing opinions and monologues.

We will continue to read for pleasure on a daily basis and continue to practise our weekly spelling rules.

History

We will be exploring the ancient civilisatons of The Indus Valley and The Shang Dynasty. This will include their lifestyle, culture and beliefs. We will discover how we, as historians, can find out about this period of history through looking a at a variety of historical evidence, including primary and secondary sources.

This term, we will be following the Jigsaw scheme of work with a focus on Relationships and Changing Me, which will also link to our science learning.
