Reading:

We will develop our reading skills through Read Write Inc. We will be continuing to develop our understanding and application of phonics.

Writing:

In writing, we will be practising writing simple sentences using finger spaces, phonics for spelling, capital letters and full stops. We will be looking in depth at The Dragon and the Nibblesome Knight and The Dragon Machine. These texts will inspire a variety of different written outcomes including descriptions, instructions, letters and recounts. In handwriting we will learn pre-cursive letter formation. in preparation for our joined-up handwriting.
