

Mathematics

In maths we will be learning about money by recognising coins and notes and finding the total. We will also be learning about fractions by recognising and finding fractions of shapes and amounts. We will be applying our knowledge to solve arithmetic and reasoning problems. We will also be learning more about clocks and how to tell the time in 5 minute intervals.

English

This term we are going to be writing fact files about seagulls, retelling the story of *The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch* and describing the character 'Mr Grinling'. We will also write an information report about chicks. After half term we will write letters of complaint about the pirates living next door, explore the text *The Mousehole Cat* and write a recount of our school trip. We will also write letters to our new class teacher at the end of the year. Each week's spelling rule will be practised through weekly homework too.

Humanities

This term we will be learning about Victorian seaside holidays, the RNLi, Grace Darling, The Titanic, the seaside as a habitat and how to keep safe at the seaside. We will find and compare different seaside locations around the world.

Religious Education
