

Mathematics

We will cover all the National Curriculum objectives for:

- Decimals
- Properties of shape
- Geometry
- Statistics
- Measurement (money and time)
- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 in advance of the statutory Year 4 multiplication check in June.

Within all units, we will challenge ourselves to solve open ended investigations using our reasoning and problem solving skills.

English

We will become Master Readers as we develop our understanding of key words within texts while also continuing to practise the skills of clarifying, summarising, inference, predicting and recalling key information.

As writers we will be:

- Writing to evoke strong emotions in a reader (imitating a first person diary entry of a character escaping from Pompeii).
- Writing to inform (set of instructions to follow in an emergency such as a volcano)
- Writing to entertain (writing a disaster story)
- Writing to persuade (persuading the Vikings to keep dragons)

Science

We will be exploring physics through electricity and sound.



Year 4 Ancient Rome

Topic — study of the Romans

As historians, we will explore how the Romans impacted Britain. As geographers, we will learn about the location of Rome using maps. We will also explore how they conquered other parts of the world.

Religious Education

In RE this term we will be exploring:
