Ancient Greece
Summer 2026

Mathematics

This term, we are beginning our units on multiplying fractions, converting units of measurement including time and volume as well as angles. Identifying, drawing and measuring angles using a protractor, properties of 2D and 3D shapes and using co-ordinates when translating and reflecting shapes.

English

As readers, we will continue to develop our summarising, clarification, predicting and questioning skills using both *The Lion Above the Door* by Onjali Q. Rauf, and *the Girl of Ink and Stars* by Kiran Millwood Hargrave, as well as a range of Greek myths. We will also continue to develop our inference skills and thinking about the author's use of language. As writers, we will consolidate a range of text types, including diary entries, explanation texts, biographies and myths.

History

As historians we will learn about the Ancient Greek way of life and how our lives have been influenced by this for example, democracy.

Religious Education:

This term we will be exploring how Buddhist teachings are interpreted by believers. Then what is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God.

Art / Design and Technology

As artists, we will explore fashion design. In design and technology, we will be making cam crank toys.

French

As linguists we will be learning about celebrations in France and Haiti, negation as well as using the verb to have — avoir. We will also look at adjectives and 'all about me'.

Computing

This term, we will be learning to use:

- MicroBits
- Make a maze game
- 3D modelling

PSHE

This term, we will be following the Jigsaw scheme of work with a focus on online relationships and Changing Me. We will also link our PSHE to our science when completing our sex and relationships unit, with a focus on the changes experienced in puberty and the life cycle of humans.

Science

As scientists, we will be investigating changes of state, including how to separate mixtures through different processes. We will also be learning about the human life cycle, including reproduction.

PE

In addition to our weekly swimming, we will be developing our fielding skills through the game of rounders as well as taking part in a range of athletics activities.
