Reading

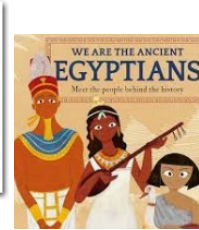
We will be focusing on being Master Readers, using our class texts to deepen our skills as readers.

The Ancient Egyptians

Summer 2026

History: As young historians, we will be exploring Egypt and the Ancient Egyptians. We will learn about the cultures, lifestyles, workplace and beliefs. We will understand the importance of the River Nile to the Ancient Egyptians, and also how the Ancient Egyptians have impacted our modern day lives too.

Geography: In Geography, we will be learning all about Rivers. Including a visit to our local river and comparing it to the River Nile. We will learn about the water cycle and the different features of a river.

Science - Light. Skeletons, Animals and Humans As scientists, we will investigate light sources, reflection, and shadow and identify opaque, translucent and transparent objects. We will also identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and they get nutrition from what they eat. We will also identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Computing

This term we will continue to follow the Purple Mash scheme of work. We will focus on coding including using microbits. We will also be using Project Evolve resources to cover E-Safety.

PSHE

This term we will be focusing on 'Relationships and Changing me'.
